Serendipity Megarip 6.0 announced

SYDNEY, Australia - June 12, 2015 - Serendipity Software today announced version 6.0 of Megarip, a major update to the software that includes many new features and enhancements to benefit new and existing customers alike.

"Megarip version 6.0 adds Jobtickets, streamlining workflows for customers with many different output devices" said Peter Skarpetis, Serendipity Software's Chief Executive Officer. Jobtickets can be shared between different devices and changed on-the-fly, increasing the flexibility and adaptability of the Megarip workflow.

Megarip version 6.0 has increased processing performance when imaging and rendering files, improved utilisation of hyper-threaded CPUs, and reduced memory and resource requirements to process jobs.

Megarip version 6.0 introduces real-time zooming to the SoftProof application. Imaged and rendered previews are generated with a pre-calculated pyramid of images, at power of 2 intervals, resulting in faster, more responsive zooming when proofing on-screen.

Megarip version 6.0 now reads the orientation data in photo files, taking the guess work out of printing smartphone and tablet photos by always rendering them the right way up.

Megarip version 6.0 adds functionality for monitoring the status of supported printers. Current status, ink levels, warnings and errors can be checked at a glance without the need to access the printer itself.

Megarip version 6.0 SoftProof can now merge spot colours directly in RGB. This significantly expands the gamut available to spot colours when printing to RGB devices.

Megarip version 6.0 features operating system integration, improving workflow efficiency by allowing users to submit or preview jobs directly from the OS file manager.

Megarip version 6.0 includes a redesigned Studio application which puts most functions a mouse click away. Tiling, guides and on-screen preview have also been improved.

Megarip version 6.0 further enhances and simplifies system security by allowing users to belong to multiple groups. This gives the system administrator fine-grained control over feature, application, job and database access for each user.

Megarip version 6.0 adds complete Client and Server backup and restore functions, providing quick recovery from failures, making it easy to move the software to new hardware, or to standardise the Client layout for multiple users.



Megarip version 6.0 introduces the Media Catalogue application. Users can now leverage online setups already created by Serendipity Software and our distribution partners to reduce the installation time for new devices.

Megarip version 6.0 supports M0, M1 and M2 spectrophotometer measurement modes, further ensuring its ability to adhere to international colour standards.

Megarip version 6.0 now supports BigTIFF files, allowing it to handle and output files larger than 4GB.

Megarip version 6.0 includes additional compression modes, further reducing the file sizes of imaging files.
